
Online Debate on "Social Wellness in Digital Age" 25-12-2021

National Library Maintenance Day 31-08-2021


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Online National Level Lecture Series on 'National Education Policy 2020 with special reference to Higher Education' 24-06-2021

Clean India: Safe India Programme 09-10-2021 to 27-10-2021



He gave a brief introduction on IPR and explained various related terms such as copyright, patent, etc. The talk gave a clear idea about the different rights granted by copyright such as the economic and moral rights, right of paternity and right of integrity which comes under the moral rights. The topic of infringement of copyright was dealt with in detail. It created a great impact on the entire audience. Students were taught on how IPR restricts copying others ideas and how this will help the development of new ideas for the betterment of the society. Students learnt how IPR provides total control over a new innovation and its creator. They were also given a platform to discuss how small innovations influence societies at large and how they should indulge in innovating and patenting ideas that will be useful for all the classes of individuals in the society. 
Constitution Day 26-11-2021
